I am equally impressed by the exhaust trail or trails following your airplane as you look behind. Another thing which really impressed me along with the detailed houses and hangar tents was the sound of a church bell as I buzzed near a village---air raid warning? The flight models seem to be remarkably faithful and utterly infuriating. You really begin to appreciate what superb fighting machines the SPAD XIII, SE5a, and Camel were after repeatedly killing yourself by overstressing a N.17. And, you certainly learn why even v.R. loathed the two-seaters! Knocking down one is truly an achievement. I have a few questions for you: (1) are there ballast and hydrogen release controls for the zep? (2) can you change the position of the SE5's Lewis gun? (3) it seems when you are flying a two-seater the rear gunner doesn't shoot---is there some way to kick him into action? There are a number of obvious glitches which I am sure you know about by now. The only one I find particularly trying is sometimes hearing sirens over your motor at 5000 feet! Godspeed to all of you and I eagerly await your for sale version.
